
Predicted Performance Level Report

A particular score on an exam depends on many variables, particularly how hard and effectively the student works between the Pro-Core assessment and the state test. This report gives the most likely performance level a student will earn on the state test. It is important that districts, schools, teachers and students realize that there is a likelihood of scoring above or below this level depending upon how hard and effectively the student works. Because of this uncertainty of this prediction, a percent chance for the student scoring at each performance level is given.



ProCore Science C Grade 5 to AIR Spring Science 5 correlation




