

Correlations between Pro-Core and Ohio's State Assessments American History

The score on any test depends upon many variables: preparation, student buy-in, specific content assessed, or how a student is feeling that day. **Comparing Pro-Core Form C American History scores to state scores gives a correlation coefficient of 0.78, which is considered strong***. Correlations between Pro-Core's Form A tests and the state tests are lower, because there is an entire year of study between them.

The following charts show the percentage of students who scored at Limited, Basic, Proficient, Accelerated and Advanced for specific scores on the Pro-Core Form A, B, and C tests. Categories which contain 25% or more students are in **bold, red font**. Most likely score ranges for each performance category are **highlighted in blue**. Students with **Pro-Core scores highlighted in red** have passed the state test at rates of 50% or less. Students with **Pro-Core Scores highlighted in yellow** have passed the state test at rates of 51% to 79%. Students with **Pro-Core Scores highlighted in green** have passed the state test at rates of 80% or more.
